Specification for Edge Break Repair

**EDGE BREAK REPAIR:** Contractor shall furnish all material, labor and equipment to do repairs at the listed street locations in the Statement of Work for the City of Woodcreek, Texas.

The completed repair shall conform to the outer edge of the pavement alignment.

For locations where the break is less than one foot (1') in from the outer edge of the alignment of the pavement the contractor shall clean all loose and unstable material from the edge of the broken pavement and apply a tack coat in accordance with 2004 TEXDOT specifications, and replace the pavement with HMAC, (Type D) asphaltic concrete compacted to 95 percent density and at a height to match the height of the existing pavement.

Should the break be in one foot (1') or further than outer edge of the pavement the edge must be sawed and tacked in accordance with the provisions required under the Street Patching Specification.

If the base is unstable, repair it in accordance with the provisions required under the Street Patching Specification.

All repairs at any given location should be completed in one day. Should it be necessary to leave the excavation open overnight or during the absence of workmen the open excavation must be protected and marked by TEXDOT approved delineators during the day and by lighted barricades after sunset.

All debris shall be removed from the work site at the completion of each patch.
