### CYPRESS CREEK PROJECT PUBLIC MEETING – June 3, 2009

The Cypress Creek Project through the River Systems Institute and Texas Stream Team will be hosting a public meeting on Wednesday, June 3, 2009 from 6:30 – 8:00 pm at the Wimberley Community Center in the Blanco Room.

The goal of the Cypress Creek Project is to ensure that the long term integrity and sustainability of the Creek and watershed are preserved and that water quality standards are maintained for present and future generations.

This will be the first meeting for the main Cypress Creek Watershed Committee which is composed of various stakeholders that have been selected to serve as committee members. While this meeting is primarily for committee members, the general public is welcome to attend and observe the process. River Systems Institute will be seeking members to participate in future meetings for sub-committee interest groups, more information regarding sub-committee groups will be posted after the June 3 meeting.

The Cypress Creek Watershed Committee will represent a wide variety of interests in the watershed and will lead the community effort to develop and implement a Watershed Management Plan. The plan will tackle Cypress Creek water quality and watershed issues by recommending strategies that also address community concerns.

The River Systems Institute, through strong Cypress Creek community partnerships, is facilitating this project. The project is paid for by grants from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the Environmental Protection Agency Region VI. River Systems Institute, Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District, and numerous other project partners are providing substantial funds to achieve project success.
